## INCLUSION OF ROMA PUPILS IN SCHOOLS

### OUTCOME:

**Increased institutional capacity of schools to ensure an effective inclusion of Roma children**

### ELIGIBILITY

**Eligible Applicants** – one NGO or public institution active in the field of Roma children inclusion, on behalf of a consortium; the successful applicant will become the project coordinator

**Eligible partners (in the consortium):** Romanian schools with minimum 20% of enrolled Roma children (with a focus of those situated in disadvantaged communities)  
**Size of the consortium:** normally, the consortium should comprise 5-6 schools

### TYPE OF PROJECTS – national partnership cooperation projects

#### Types of activities in projects:

- Training of teachers in areas such as: teaching approach centered on pupils, inclusive school and teaching in a multicultural environment, democracy and citizenship education, tolerance, anti-discrimination, human/pupils rights, etc.
- Elaboration of new optional curricula and teaching material on inclusiveness and multicultural environment
- Learning activities on social inclusion and anti-discrimination issues for Roma and non-Roma parents together
- Extra-curricular awareness raising activities on inclusion for Roma and non-Roma children to foster social inclusion and competences

**PROJECT DURATION:** 12 – 24 months

### TYPES OF COSTS

#### Project Management and Implementation

Coordinator (NGO/public institution), unit cost:  
 • 500 €/month of project

Partner organization, unit cost:  
 • 250 € / month

#### Training/learning/extra-curricular activities

The costs for training/learning/extracurricular activities take the form of unit costs, the unit being the staff cost corresponding for 1 working day (8 working hours)

The following rate applies:

74 €/working day for trainers or facilitators involved in the following activities:

- training of the teachers
- learning activities with parents
- extra-curricular activities with pupils

#### Travel

The costs for travel take the form of unit costs, as following:

Cost/participant according to distances (scale of unit costs): between 20 – 275 €

#### Organisational costs for extra-curricular activities with pupils

The costs for organising the extra-curricular activities with pupils in the case these activities take place outside the school will take the form of unit cost: 20 €/pupil/activity day
