## MOBILITY PROJECTS IN HIGHER EDUCATION

**OUTCOME:**  
**Improved skills and competences of students and staff in Higher Education (HE)**

### ELIGIBILITY

#### Eligible applicants: only from Romania

Romanian Higher Education Institutions (HEI) possessing an ERASMUS University Charter

#### Eligible project partners:

Legal entities established in the Donor States (DS)

Swiss universities, with respect to the students of Liechtenstein nationality

### TYPE OF PROJECTS-Mobility projects PARTICIPANTS IN MOBILITY:

Participants in mobility could be:

- Students in any study cycle (bachelor, master, PhD) and recent graduates
  - Staff of a HEI (teaching or non-teaching staff)
- NB: for study mobility, the students should be enrolled at least in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the 1-st cycle

#### Types of activities in projects:

- Learning mobility of the students, for study and/or traineeships
- Staff mobility: teaching assignment or training mobility

#### Duration of the learning activities:

Students mobility for study: from 3 to 12 months

Students mobility for traineeships: from 2 to 12 months

Teaching mobility :from 2 consecutive working days to 2 weeks (excluding travel time).

Training mobility: from 2 consecutive working days to 2 weeks (excluding travel time).

### TYPES OF COSTS:

#### Travel

The costs for travel take the form of unit costs, according to the distance band ( for students and staff mobility):

- Distances between 10-99 km: 20 EUR / participant
- Distances between 100-499 km: 180EUR / participant
- Distances between 500-1999 km: 275 EUR / participant
- Distances between 2000-2999 km: 360 EUR / participant
- Distances between 3000-3999 km: 530 EUR / participant
- Distances between 4000-7999 km: 820 EUR / participant

#### Individual support (subsistence of participants)

The individual support takes the form of unit costs, as following:

For students:

- individual support (subsistence) for Romanian students undertaking a study or traineeships mobility to one of the DS - 1200 € /month
- individual support (subsistence) for DS students coming for study or traineeships to Romania - 1000 € /month
